The logo of the Moderator Gladstone CSI Institute of Legal Studies is a harmonious blend of faith, culture, and the ideals of justice. It comprises a Cross superimposed on a stylized lotus flower, along with the scales of justice and an advocate's emblem, flanked by olive leaves on either side, all set against a white background. The logo bears the motto: "The Truth Shall Set You Free."

The imposing central position of the Cross denotes the foundation of the Church and its faith, while its four arms of equal length promulgate equality, inclusiveness, and balance.

The lotus flower, known as "Pankaj" (meaning "mud-born" in Sanskrit), has held deep spiritual and symbolic significance in India since ancient times. Its presence in the logo proclaims the indigenous nature of the Church of South India and reflects its dependence on the grace of God. Just as the lotus blooms at sunrise and closes at sunset, it symbolizes reliance on divine light. The stylized rendering of the lotus petals also evokes the imagery of the fiery, divided tongues of the Holy Spirit, signifying divine inspiration and guidance.

The scales of justice represent fairness, impartiality, and the ethical administration of law, corresponding to the metaphor of matters being "held in the balance."

The advocate's emblem signifies the institution's mission of shaping young, socially responsible lawyers committed to justice and nation-building.

The olive leaves on either side symbolize peace, harmony, and reconciliation—values integral to both law and faith. The white background represents purity, peace, and integrity.

The motto, "The Truth Shall Set You Free," is drawn from the Bible (John 8:32) and conveys that the knowledge of truth liberates and empowers individuals.

In 2025, the institution was renamed to include "Moderator Gladstone" in its title, as a mark of deep respect and gratitude to the Most Rev. J. W. Gladstone, former Moderator and Bishop of the CSI South Kerala Diocese, in recognition of his invaluable contributions to the Church, the community, and society at large.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE AND COURSE REGULATIONS

B.A LL.B, B.B.A LL.B, B.Com LL.B Integrated Degree Courses (five year)

Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary or the Plus Two examination recognized by the Government of Kerala with not less than 45% marks or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto by the University of Kerala with the minimum prescribed marks are eligible for being considered for admission to the five year Integrated LL.B courses. In the case of S.C and S.T candidates, the percentage of marks will be relaxed by 5%. The candidates belonging to OBC categories will get a relaxation of 3%. The maximum number of students to be admitted in each integrated course shall be limited to sixty. Out of this, thirty seats shall be filled through the Kerala Law Entrance Examination conducted by the Government of Kerala and the remaining thirty seats shall be filled by the Management on the basis of the marks scored in the qualifying examination. The Integrated BA LL.B, BBA LL.B and B.Com LL.B degree courses spread over five years' duration consisting of ten semesters and each year is divided into two semesters. Each semester consists of 90 working days.

LL.B Unitary Degree Course (Three year)

Candidates who have passed any Bachelor's Degree examination of the University of Kerala or any other University recognized by the University of Kerala with not less than 45% marks are eligible for being considered for admission to the first year of the three year LL.B degree course. The said percentage of marks shall be relaxed by 5% for SC/ST categories and 3% for OBC categories. The number of students to be admitted in the three year LL.B course shall be sixty. Out of this, thirty seats shall be filled through the Kerala Law Entrance Examination conducted by the Government of Kerala and the remaining thirty seats shall be filled by the Management on the basis of the marks scored in the qualifying examination. Each academic year is divided into two semesters and each semester consists of 90 working days.



LL.M (Two years)

A candidate who has passed the LL.B Degree Examination of the University of Kerala or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto by the University of Kerala with not less than 50% marks is eligible to be considered for admission to LL.M Course. A candidate who has passed the qualifying examination from any University other than the University of Kerala shall produce the Eligibility Certificate of the University of Kerala. The maximum number of students to be admitted to the LL.M Course shall be limited to fifteen. Out of this, seven seats shall be filled from the Kerala State Entrance Test and the remaining eight seats shall be filled by the management as per the Institutional norms based on merit. The LL.M course is of two years' duration consisting of four semesters. Each semester consists of ninety Instructional days. At the end of each semester, there shall be a University Examination. Each paper carries 100 marks which is divided into 60 marks for the University examination and 40 marks for the Internal Assessment. No Student shall be eligible to appear for the University examination at the end of each semester unless the Principal certifies that the candidate has attended not less than 75% of the classes in each paper and that his conduct and progress have been satisfactory. The fees fixed by the Government of Kerala will be collected from the LL.M students. The students shall compulsorily wear the uniform dress in the college campus and the details of the uniform are described in the succeeding paragraphs.

 - (vii) In case the candidate claims any sort of reservation/ privileges, documents to prove such claims.**
 - (viii) Certificate in proof of OBC/OEC/SC/ST and Non Creamy Layer status from the Tahasildar /Village Officer/Authority concerned.**
 - (ix) Medical Certificate to prove fitness.**
 - (x) Migration Certificate for the candidates eligible from the other State Board and Other Universities.**
 - (xi) Eligibility Certificate from the University of Kerala.**
- 5. Two Sets photocopies of all the documents /certificates listed above duly attested by a Gazetted Officer/Head of the Institution the student last studied.**
- 6. Four passport size photos and One Stamp size photo of the candidate**
- 7. Stamp paper worth 100 rupees in the name of the candidate, to sign undertaking by student & parent**

GRIEVANCES RELATING TO ADMISSION

Any grievance/complaint relating to selection and admission can be brought to the notice of the Principal of the college within 24 hours of the occurrence of such grievance.

APPLICATION FORM

Application forms can be obtained from the CSI ILS at Cheruvarakonam, Parassala by submitting a requisition letter. Application fee for the general candidates Rs.1000/- and Rs.500/- for SC/ST candidate.

TIMINGS

The regular timings of the college are from 8.30 am to 1.30pm. Students and faculties has to be in the class and college before 8.25 am

DENIAL OF ADMISSION

- 1. The management will have the right to deny admission to any candidate if it is found that his/her character antecedents are questionable on genuine grounds.**
- 2. At the time of the Admission, the selected candidates should produce before the Principal all original documents to prove their claims made in the application form.**
- 3. The candidates shall take admission on the notified date. The candidates who do not take admission on the prescribed date will lose their admission.**



General Discipline

The students are expected to maintain cordial and respectful relations with each of the staff. They should also ensure that this relationship is only to pursue their programme of study at this college and as such they should observe the following restraints:

1. Students must attend lectures as per the timetable. And should do the tasks assigned by the faculties in charge.
2. No student shall do anything that will disrupt teaching, curricular or extracurricular activities, examinations, administrative work, etc.
3. Ragging or any type of misconduct inside and outside the campus towards any student shall be treated as very serious. Ragging is a criminal offence and will be reported to the police. Perpetrators of the offence will not be permitted to continue their studies and stringent action will be taken against them as per law.
4. No student Organization owing allegiance to any political party in the State or any other organization shall be allowed to function inside the college campus. The meeting of any such organizations, hoisting of flags, taking procession, raising of slogans, pasting posters and binging badges and banners to back up student politics in the college campus or entering into any class while classes are going on shall not be allowed. The student politics in the campus leads to indiscipline hindering the peace and harmony inside the college. It leads to chaos in the academic atmosphere of the college. To protect the interests of the student's fraternity, the college management has banned student politics in the college campus. Disciplinary action will be initiated against those who violate the above directions.
5. No society or association shall be formed in the college without the prior permission of the Principal.
6. No student shall display any notice/circular/poster/banner on the college premises without the prior permission of the Principal.
7. All types of protest demonstrations, processions, shouting, etc. are prohibited within the college premises.
8. All meetings, cultural programs, debates, etc. organized on the college premises must be conducted in the presence of faculty members and with the prior permission of the Principal.
9. Outsiders are not permitted in the college premises without the prior permission of the Principal.
10. Smoking and use of alcoholic substances, drugs, pan masala, etc. are strictly prohibited on the college premises.
11. Strict action will be taken against students involved in malpractices at University/college examinations.
12. Students shall not do anything that will tarnish the image of the college while they are inside or outside the college campus.
13. Strict action will be taken against the student damaging college property and such students will have to compensate for the damage caused.
14. The campus is a green campus students are expected to dispose of all kinds of garbage in the bins that are provided in the class, campus, and canteen. Littering will lead to fine.
15. Students are strictly prohibited from writing anything on the walls, desks, and benches or from indulging in defacing/graffiti writing especially in the toilets. Anyone found doing so will have to pay the cost of painting the wall or room as the case may be.
16. All directions issued by the authorities for the smooth functioning of the college have to be complied with by all students.

UNIVERSITY EXAMINATION AND INTERNAL ASSESMENT

At the end of each semester, there shall be a university examination. Each written paper carrying. 100 marks is divided into 80 marks for the external university examination and 20 marks for the internal assessment. The twenty marks for the internal assessment shall be awarded by the Teacher concerned based on the following guidelines:-

(1) Attendance - Five marks

(2.5 marks for 75% attendance and additional 0.5 marks for every 5% of attendance above 75%)

(2) Test paper - Five marks

(Minimum two test papers)

(3) Assignment - Five marks

(4) Seminar - Five marks

MOBILE PHONE USAGE POLICY

The use of mobile phones within the college campus is strictly regulated, particularly during class hours, in order to maintain an environment conducive to learning and academic discipline.

Students who bring mobile phones to the campus are required to switch off their devices and deposit them in the designated storage area provided within their respective classrooms before the commencement of classes. Access to these devices will be permitted only after the completion of class hours.

DISCIPLINARY MEASURES

Any violation of this policy will be dealt with strictly:

- First violation: Fine of ₹1,000
- Second violation: Fine of ₹2,000
- Third violation: Suspension from the institution



College Uniform & Identity Card Regulations

All students are required to adhere strictly to the prescribed dress code on all regular working days. This regulation shall come into effect from the commencement of the new academic session in June 2026

UNIFORM FOR BOYS

- White full-sleeved formal shirt, neatly tucked into black formal trousers (cotton/terrycot material only)
- Black formal shoes with white socks
- Wearing of jeans is strictly prohibited

UNIFORM FOR GIRLS

- Plain black churidar bottom with white top (cotton/terrycot material only)
- Black waistcoat
- Black formal shoes with white socks
- Headscarf, if worn, must be plain black
- Use of tights or netted materials is strictly prohibited



UNIFORM FOR LL.M. GIRL STUDENTS

- White churidar (both top and bottom) (cotton/terrycot material only)
- Black formal shoes with white socks
- Use of tights or netted materials is strictly prohibited

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Entry into the college premises will be permitted only to students in proper uniform.
- All students must carry and display their identity card at all times within the campus. The ID card must be worn visibly using the official tag issued by the institution.
- Students who have not obtained their ID cards must collect the same from the College Office upon payment of the prescribed fee, on or before 01 June 2026.

Any violation of the above regulations will be viewed seriously and may result in disciplinary action



FEES STRUCTURE

1. The Fees will be collected as per the rules of the Government of Kerala.
2. Each year fees should be paid one week prior to start of next year, No student will be allowed to attend the classes without paying the fees.
3. The refund deposit of Rs 50,000 will be returned to the student only while he/she is issued with TC after completion of course. It will NOT repeat NOT be adjusted against fees for last year.
4. E-grantz should be deposited in college account within 2 days of receipt of money in the bank by students. If default in payment is made after the student has received the money from Government them the student will not be permitted to attend the classes till he/she deposit the same to college account.
5. The Caution deposit of rupees 5,000/- will be refunded after reducing the aluminifees (Rs 1000/-) and recovering the damages or losses made to college property, made by the student.
6. These rules are to be strictly abided by all students to ensure smooth functioning of college. Parents are hereby requested to read these rules and strictly adhere to the time schedules.

FEE PAYMENT REGULATIONS

All students are required to pay the prescribed course fee on an annual basis. The fee for each academic year must be paid in full prior to the commencement of the new academic year.

Students who fail to remit the fees within the stipulated time may not be permitted to attend classes or access institutional facilities until the dues are cleared.

The institution reserves the right to impose late fees or take appropriate administrative action in case of delay or non-payment.

All students and parents/guardians are advised to ensure timely payment of fees to avoid any disruption in academic activities.
